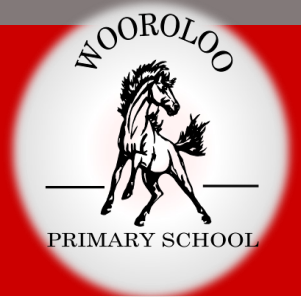

Mighty, Mighty Mathletics

Wooroloo Primary School subscribes to Mathletics, an online program that underpins our whole school Numeracy program. Mathletics is an online program, but also provides teachers with printable workbooks suitable for use in multi-aged classrooms. Teachers print the student workbooks and set students online tasks to support each topic being covered in their workbook.

Each year group works on the same topic at the same time, but the content is adjusted to their year group, or student ability level. Each concept presented in the workbook begins with an explanation and examples. The tasks get more complex as students work through the concept, thereby building student fluency in each concept. Each concept is reviewed and assessed with a standardised assessment. Mathletics also has year level assessments to assist in

identifying student's strengths and areas that need further development.

Once students have completed their online set tasks they can access maths based games. They can also compete in a series of online games, against students at their level, both within the school or further afield. The students in Room 5 have a unique method of recording their wins and losses - they place a pin in the world map to identify the country against which they competed. Different colour pins denote the outcome.

Being an online maths program, Mathletics provides opportunity for students to access their set tasks from the classroom or anywhere with an internet connection. Mathletics is a great way for parents to get involved with their child's learning as they are able to see what their children are working on and provide support and assistance where needed.
